

## Year-Round Reading Program for Babies, Toddlers & Preschoolers

## What is it?

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten is a new program at Maxwell Memorial Library that promotes reading to babies, toddlers, and preschoolers. It encourages parent/caregiver and child bonding through reading. While 1,000 books may seem like a lot, remember reading just one book to your child a night for a year is already 365! Don't forget that repeats count, so if your child has a favorite book that you read together over and over, each time you read it, it counts so write it down!

## Earn Cool Prizes with Your Child!

We offer incentives to children who reach certain reading marks. For every 100 books read and recorded the child will receive a sticker and sometimes a small prize as well. To claim your prizes, submit your child's completed reading logs to library staff. You will then receive your next reading log and a sticker or small prize. Your child will also have their name on one of our reading owls so we can track their reading on our 1000 books wall!
